2025 Upper Mississippi River Navigation Closeout Letter

Dear Valued Customers,

In preparation for the closing of the 2025 navigation season for the Upper Mississippi River during the winter months, the following tentative dates should be used for planning purposes.

As operating conditions and weather dictate, these dates may be extended or shortened as the navigation season closes.

The following dates are our Upper Mississippi final departure dates (for southbound loads, 0700 release):

St. Paul, MN – PDC, WI (UM857-640) (includes barge traffic for the Minnesota River)

Sunday, November 23

PDC, WI – Clinton, IA (UM639-521)

Sunday, November 30

Clinton, IA – Ft. Madison (UM520-383)

Sunday, December 7

Off-loading Instructions at Destination - Important Details

Shippers, please plan with your customers so that all barges are off-loaded at destination, at least <u>10 days prior</u> to our scheduled final departure dates (listed above). Ten days will be needed to prepare and plan barges (clean/reload barges back to St.Louis). Barges that are not off-loaded in a timely manner may incur additional charges (i.e. winter storage, towing charges, etc.).

The following dates should be used by Shippers as "final loading dates" (0700 release) from points of origin to destinations on the Upper Mississippi (above St. Louis).
